## Our commitment in Italy and Europe

Focsiv and its members operate across Italy and Europe with various initiatives aimed at engaging citizens and institutions, in line with the 2030 Agenda objectives.

- **Information and Advocacy:** public events, digital campaigns, and policy papers on workers' rights, land grabbing, and the right to food, fundraising and awareness campaigns to support sustainable development.
- **Global Citizenship Education Projects:** programs on integration, environmental sustainability, and responsible lifestyles; support for migrant communities and social inclusion initiatives.
- **070 Campaign "The World is Hungry. For Development.":** a national initiative to allocate 0.70% of Italy's GNI to public development aid, promoted by Focsiv in collaboration with AOI, CINI, and Link 2007.
- **Training and Capacity Building:** courses and master programs at the School of International Politics (SPICeS), educational projects in schools to promote global citizenship.

With **over 600 projects worldwide**, Focsviv works alongside vulnerable communities, promoting **education, health, sustainable development, and humanitarian aid**. Through local partnerships, we strengthen economies, ensure food security, and support social inclusion.

- **Education & Training:** 264 projects in schools, vocational training, and universities.

- **Humanitarian Aid:** 27 projects in crisis and conflict zones.
- **Economic Development:** 130 projects supporting local economies.
- **Health & Nutrition:** 185 projects providing medical care and food security.
- **Environment & Climate:** 53 projects focused on sustainability.

Active in **Africa, Latin America, Asia, Europe, and the Middle East**, including **key projects** in **Ukraine, Iraq, and Syria** to **promote stability** and **humanitarian assistance**.
